The consumption of Halal is mandatory

Ban to consume Haram

“O messengers, eat of the good things, and act with integrity. I am aware of what you do.” (Qur’an 23: 51)

A story is told about a man who makes a long journey in a disheveled and dusty state, having lost his horse in the desert, who stretches out his hands to heaven saying "My Lord, my lord," the Prophet

Muhammad (PBUH) said: "how could such a man be given an answer, when his food, drink and clothing are of an unlawful nature, and he is nourished by what is unlawful?" [Muslim, Tirmidhî et Ahmad]

The Haram or Doubtful poultry of these brands is labelled with the Halal mention

The doubtful is strongly misadvised

To protect his faith, the Muslim must avoid the doubtful

“Both legal [halal] and illegal [haram] things are evident. But in between them there are doubtful (suspicious) things and most of the people have no knowledge about them. So whoever saves himself from these suspicious things saves his religion and his honor. And whoever indulges in these

suspicious things is like a shepherd who grazes (his animals) near the Hima (private pasture) of someone else and at any moment the animals are liable to get in it. (O people!) Beware! Every king has a Hima and the Hima of Allah on the earth is His illegal (forbidden) things (...)" [Bukhari, Muslim].

Illicit or ambiguous products

« Certainly do not go into the paradise a flesh which was fed by Haram » [Authenticated by Albani]. For decades in France, companies, those have been assisted or not by Muslim profiteers, have labeled Haram products with the Halal mention. Among these Haram products, we find food that is sold without any certification, auto-certified, not respecting the religious standards (Religious References for Halal of the French Council of Muslim Worship), certified without actual control, and other food that are certified by non-Muslims (ex: France Qualité - Veritas). Only a list of the names of these Haram or Doubtful products can allow the consumers to unequivocally identify them and to knowingly act. This bulletin proposes to the consumers the first not exhaustive list of Haram food that is labelled Halal in France. It should be gradually completed.

Haram or Doubtful Products

The processed products and the packaged meats that are labelled halal and sold in the medium and large wholesalers are for the main part Haram. With the exception of some locally produced and rare certified products, all of the poultry in France metropolis and Overseas is Haram or Doubtful.

To ensure the halal quality, the Muslims are called to get organized locally. To that end, ASIDCOM suggests you free trainings.
